## **Russian-Chinese Political Relations**

(Summary)

This article is dedicated to the new stages in the development of the Russian-Chinese political relations, influenced by the changes in the USSR and the Chinese People's Republic in the beginning of the XXth century. The article takes a closer look at the up-s and down-s in the political relations between the two countries and the rising awareness about the new regional, continental and world changes demanding a due reconsideration of the Russian-Chinese relations. It is taken under consideration the normalizing of the synallagmatic relations in 1989 and the interior political and international relations. Russia and Chins manage to overcome in a decade the descend in the synallagmatic relations and to estimate their coinciding interests in security, economical and scientific cooperation and common actions in Asia. Since 1992 until the end of the XX century Russia and China carry out a diplomatic preparation for adopting new documents for good will concerning the diplomacy, politics and defence. The following development of equal relations, without suspicion and secret clauses, are embodied by high-level meetings and visits, political negotiations and signing new treaties and reaching new agreements. By joint efforts the Russian Federation and Chinese People's Republic manage to reach military and political cooperation, common stands on global security problems, protection for the national interests and extension of their participation in the Asian international relations.
