The work of the Bulgarian Specialists and Workers in Mongolia in the 1960–1980s

(Summary)

At first amongst the Bulgarian workers in Mongolia predominate the architects, building engineers, who design and manage the erection of many building projects: housing construction, administrative buildings and public works, land improvement projects, sports and resort complexes and etc. Since the second half of the 1960s Bulgarians build and manage several enterprises, important for the Mongolian economics: The Leather Factory in the town of Darhan, the packing-house in Choybalsan, the pig-breeding farm and the greenhouses in Ulan Bator, 14 pottery factories and brickyards in different towns throughout the country. In Mongolia works a large group of vets and several geological teams. A gold-mining union is established as well. Bulgarians also found and manage the large agricultural enterprise "Orhon-Sharingol". Many scientific workers: agronomists, stock-breeders, medics, technologists, computer experts and etc., are on a long-term business trip in the country.
