SCHOOL LEGISLATION IN THE RENAISSANCE

(Summary)

Several very interesting pieces of work focus on the problems with the education and culture during the Revival. Vera Boneva reviews the "School legislation in the Renaissance" in an article of the same name. It is based on 16 school statute-books from the late 1830s, 1840s till the 1870s. It discusses the main formulations that regulate different aspects of the Revival education - organization, internal regulation, funding, functions of the school board, the teachers' commitments and the pupils' obligations, the school documentation and etc.
